

Answer:

Any vessel less than 50 meters in length is required to exhibit a single all around white light when at anchor, located where it can best be seen. This can be a permanently installed purpose-built light, or a lantern hoisted aloft for this purpose. In either case, a minimum 2-mile visibility is required. Vessels less than 7 meters in length are not required to show this light provided that they are not in or near a narrow channel, fairway or anchorage, or where other vessels normally navigate.

In the daytime, a vessel over 20m in length is required to display a single ball shape should be displayed in the forepart of the vessel.
